## FALL 2023 APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS & INFORMATION

- For Grants are available to junior and senior high school Family & Consumer Science Classes for the purpose of educating students about beef. The beef purchased will be used in a recipe of the teacher's choice and prepared by the students in said cooking class.
- Grants of <u>up to</u> \$250 must be used for the purchase of BEEF. Please note, the OBC will determine the grant amounts for each school.
- These lessons may include fresh, frozen, or heat-and-serve beef products.
- > Once the application is received and reviewed, the OBC will notify award winners of approval and of the grant amount. Any purchase that occurs before notification by the OBC, will not necessarily be honored.
- Application deadline is October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. Approval date no later than October 20, 2023
- Schools can also request educational materials pertaining to the beef industry at no additional cost, you can also download & print these materials & recipes from our website at www.oklabeef.org. (Available on your FCS website)
- Funds are awarded on a reimbursement basis to the school post cooking class.
- Activity must conclude no later than May 1, 2024.
- Receipts showing the purchase of beef must be included with the final report to secure reimbursement of awarded funds must be received by OBC post marked May 10, 2024.
